



Bulletin Editor's contest

It again is time for all bulletin editors in the Ontario District to start planning to prepare their entries for the *Bulletin Editor of The Year (BETY) contest*. Every bulletin entered will be returned with a scoring summary, comments, critiques and suggestions from the judges.

The winners will be announced at the district spring convention. The top two bulletins in the Ontario District (if the editor is a member of PROBE) will be entered in the *International Bulletin Contest (IBC)*.

If you publish your bulletin on a monthly or bi-monthly basis, submit two sets of three copies of three consecutive issues (that is a total of 18 issues, six of each of three consecutive issues). At least one copy of each of the three consecutive issues must be an off-the-press copy (not a photocopy of the published bulletin). At least six issues of the bulletin must have been published in 2007.

Contact me for information on the criteria for weekly or bi-weekly bulletins. If you publish your bulletin electronically to the web and would like to enter that contest, contact me for further details.

At the beginning of January, submit your bulletins to me along with a letter stating the number of issues that you produced in 2007 and whether you are a member of PROBE. When you send them to me, please notify me that you are sending them by mail since I must receive them before January 15, 2008.
